PERSONAL ITEMS BROUGHT TO CAMP

GUIDELINES 2017 CAMP ROOTED

Campers are expected to show respect to all camp personnel and staff at all times; as well as, abide by the rules and schedule of classes and activities. They are to be in every class and service. There is to be NO smoking. Cursing, vile, and otherwise rude or vulgar language and behavior is absolutely prohibited.

YOUNG MEN: No facial hair, neat haircuts with hair so as not to hang over the top of the collar; may not cover the top of the ears and cannot hang in the eyes; must be kept combed.

Trousers must be modest. No muscle shirts or sleeveless shirts. No shorts.
